Agreement for collaborators within project: Toward Gender Harmony – Understanding the Relationship between Masculinity Threat and Gender Equality Across Cultures

I _____hereby confirm that I will be a collaborator in the project entitled: Toward Gender Harmony – Understanding the Relationship between Masculinity Threat and Gender Equality Across Cultures.

As a collaborator involved in the project, I understand and agree to the following terms and guidelines:

- I will ensure and document proper ethical clearance for the study conducted under the project in accordance with my institution's policies.
- I will (with assistance from the project coordinator) translate the survey used in the study to the language appropriate for my sample.
- I will ensure that both the contents of the survey and the process of data collection are of high quality and appropriate cultural sensitivity.
- I will collect data from at least 200 participants, with at least 100 men and 100 women, each of whom passes the attention checks in the questionnaire. This will be completed by October 30th, 2019.
- The data will be collected online through an online survey service overseen by the project coordinator, and the study link will be sent to me by the project coordinator.
- If an online study is not possible at my university, I will use pencil and paper to collect data.
- The participants will be students. They should be all students from an undergraduate/bachelor (or similar) program of psychology or any other major.
- Should there be any problems in collecting the above-mentioned number of participants I will inform the project coordinator as soon as I become aware of the problem.
- I will complete the questionnaire detailing information about the data collection site and its specific context (sent to researchers upon completion of data collection).
- I will be granted co-authorship of the two multi-country peer-reviewed publications from this project that include my data.
- I will have unrestricted access to my own collected data and may always publish my own data with or without involvement from other collaborators on this project.
- If I desire to publish my own ideas/hypothesis using the overall cross-cultural dataset, I must first consult with the project coordinator and seek agreement before proceeding. I understand that every attempt will be made to allow me access to the full dataset, but that the nature of data collection and number of cross-cultural collaborators make this a sensitive issue and all final decisions will be made by the project coordinator.
